SCHOOL MEAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

Dear parents of Moscow Middle School students:

Meal Accounts and Charges:

The end of the school year is quickly approaching and we will soon need to file all the meal accounts. **Please pay all charges due.** No charges will be allowed after May 12. If you have questions about meal charges call Mimi Pengilly at the number below. Any credit or charges left on student's accounts at the end of the year will be automatically carried over to the next year. If your child transfers to another school within the district, their credits (or charges) will go to their account at their new school. If you are leaving the district, please call Mimi Pengilly at 892-1123 to arrange for a refund.

Free and Reduced price meal benefits:

If your family qualifies for Free or Reduced Price meal benefits, you can begin next school year with that benefit until your new application is processed; (the grace period ends October 1, 2017). We will send out new applications at the beginning of the school year. The Free and Reduced meal program is based on household size and monthly income. This helpful program benefits the school in two ways: as an important source of funds for educational programs as well as nutrition programs. We urge you to apply.

Meal Prices:

Meal prices will increase for the 2017-2018 school year; however, the price increase has not yet been determined. School meals are high quality, nutritious meals for the lowest prices in town.

Summer Lunch Program is BACK BY POPULAR DEMAND!!!

The Moscow School District will offer USDA summer lunch, free to all children between the ages of 1 to 18. The meals will be served outside Lena Whitmore School. Lunch is served from 11:30 AM to 12:30 PM Monday through Friday. Final plans are underway...It is planned that the program will begin on Wednesday June 14 and will end on August 11. There are no applications to complete; all children eat lunch for free. Parents are welcome to purchase a lunch for \$3.75. Enjoy the playground, restrooms, picnic shelter and convenient central location...close to the bus line.
